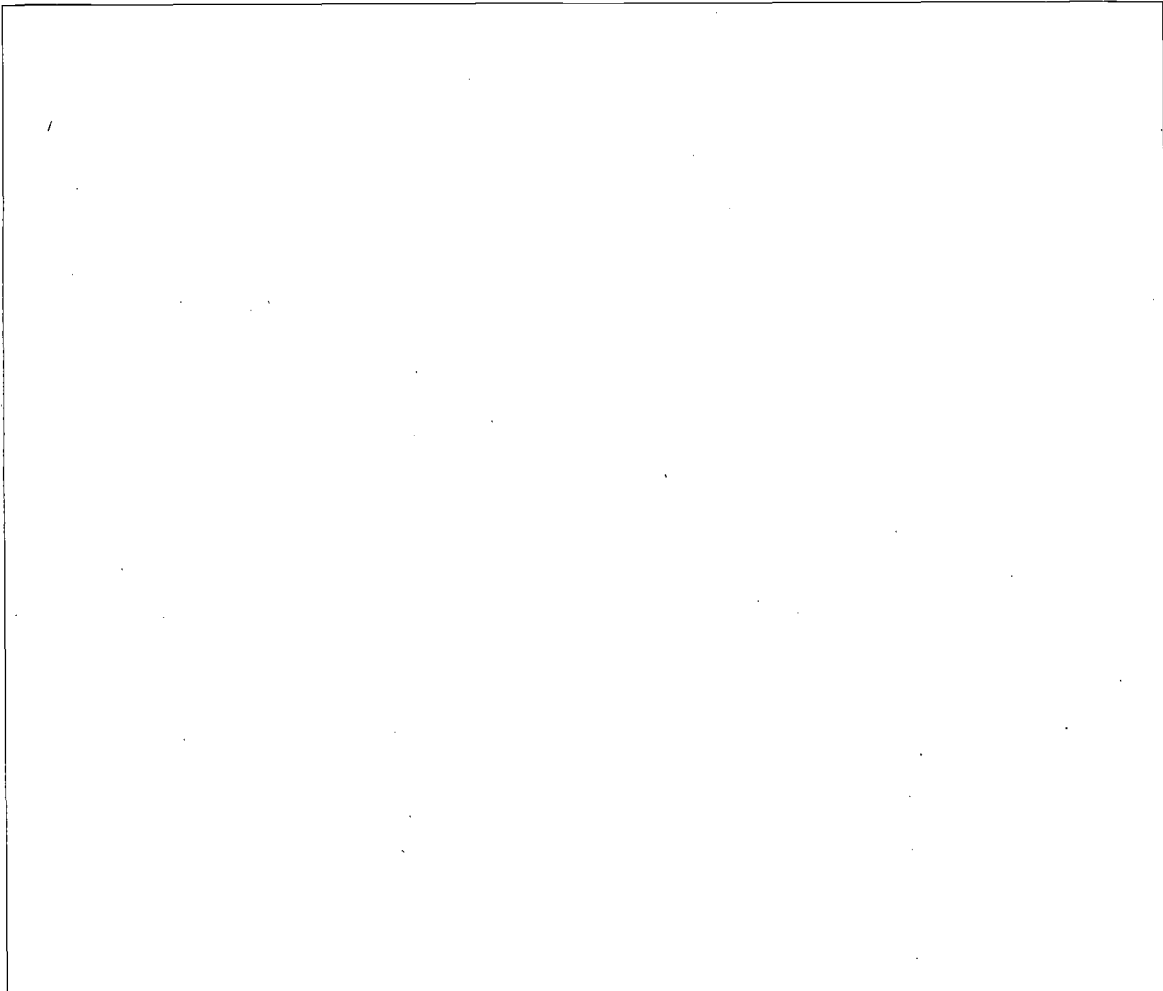

 flights over Manchuria during the past weeks, after a period of silence
 on this issue, suggests a Chinese intention to warn the Chinese people
 not to expect progress at the cease-fire conference.

Comment: The most serious charge to date was leveled on 13 January,
 when both Communist negotiators and propaganda broadcasts scored the
 "deliberate provocation" of a series of over-flights as far west as
 Mukden on that day.

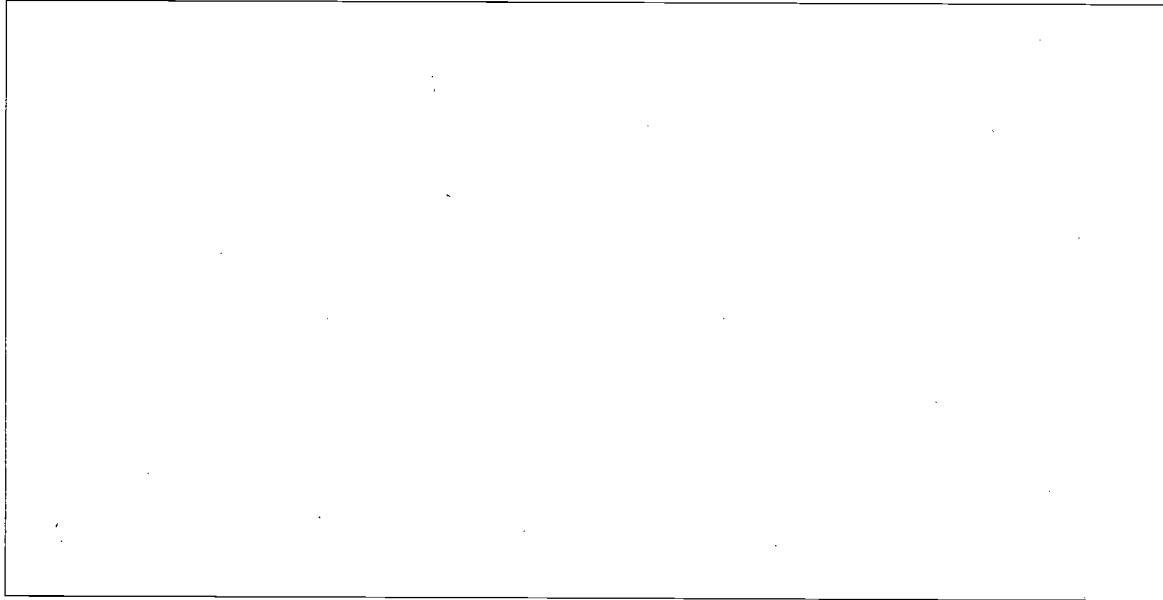
